Short for ASD Youth for Community, Engagement and Socialization, AYCES is a life skills and activity program designed to support youth diagnosed with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) who may face challenges in understanding social cues and in forming or maintaining personal relationships. To be eligible, participants must be 12–18 years old and living at home.



AYCES provides a safe, consistent and fun environment necessary for youth to learn the social skills needed to promote independence, pro-social relationships and an increased sense of belonging.

- Life Skill Development
- Peers Relationships
- Volunteerism
